# Exploring Biodiversity Through Innovative Pedagogy: A 3-Day Professional Development Course

#### Course Description:

Join us for a comprehensive three-day course designed for educators interested in enhancing their teaching of biodiversity through praxis-based didactic and pedagogical methods. This program combines theoretical knowledge with practical, hands-on experiences to address Biodiversity in urban and rural areas, opportunities and obstacles of implementing Biodiversity action with a knowledge –based purpose in mind.

#### **Day 1: Foundations and Misconceptions**

- **Morning Session:** Introduction to biodiversity definitions, global importance, and ecological principles. Exploring common misconceptions about biodiversity and their origins, and strategies to address them in educational settings.
- **Excursion:** Visit to the Dome in Aarhus and the Marselisborg Centre to observe and study local biodiversity and climate-adaptation efforts. Participants will engage in guided tours and activities that illustrate the practical aspects of biodiversity teaching.

#### Day 2: Innovative Teaching Methods and Technologies

- **Morning Session:** Problem-based learning approaches in biodiversity education, focusing on student engagement and real-world applications.
- Afternoon Session: Integrating virtual reality (VR) in teaching biodiversity. This includes hands-on training with VR tools to simulate ecosystems and biodiversity scenarios.

#### Day 3: Implementation, Evaluation, and Wrap-Up

- Workshop 1: Design your own lecture on Biodiversity in an aspect and pedagogical approach of your own choice.
- Workshop 2: Design your own VR educational environment.
- Closing Session: Reflection and discussion on implementing learned methods and technologies in participants' teaching practices.

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**Target Audience:** This course is ideal for educators at VET level, especially those teaching Biodiversity, sustainability, who wish to innovate their teaching methods and engage students in learning about Biodiversity through interactive and immersive technologies.

Learning Outcomes: Participants will leave the course with:

- 1. A deeper understanding of Biodiversity and its global significance.
- 2. Practical skills in addressing misconceptions in the classroom.
- 3. Experience in employing problem-based learning and technologies like VR in teaching.
- 4. Insights from real-world examples of Biodiversity through professional excursions.


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### How to get to Green Academy?

We recommend flying to either Billund Airport or Aarhus Airport. If you arrive in Copenhagen, you'll need to take a train to Aarhus. From Billund to Aarhus, take Bus number 912 X, and from Aarhus Airport to Aarhus, take Bus number 925 X.

To get from Aarhus to the Green Academy, known as Jordbrugets UddannelsesCenter Aarhus in Danish, located at Damgårds Alle 5, 8330 Beder, you can follow these directions:



To get to **BEDER** from **Aarhus**, you'll need to catch bus number **100** departing from **Jægergårdsgade/M**. **P. Bruuns Gade** (Aarhus Kom). It's a short walk of 88 meters from the train station. If you're unsure, feel free to ask for directions. Keep in mind that there are two buses numbered 100 going in different directions, so ensure you're on the one heading to **Beder**.

The bus stop in Beder is located 400 m from the school.

After you arrive to school call the duty person at **+4523725220**. This person will provide you with the keys.

The responsible person is available from **19:00** on **Sundays** until **16:00** on **Fridays**.
